1. Terms and Conditions

1.1. These Terms and Conditions comprise a number of rights and responsibilities relevant to Members and Affiliates. They become binding on a Member or Affiliate once that Member or Affiliate has applied for, and subsequently been accepted to a type of membership or affiliate subscription.

1.2 All Members and Affiliates are subject to the Regulations of Skateboard GB and agree to be bound by and observe all other codes, regulations, rules, and policies published by Skateboard GB from time to time. 1.3 The Codes, Regulations, Rules and Policies of Skateboard GB apply to all Members and Affiliates for a minimum of 12 months from the commencement, or renewal of membership or affiliation.

1.4 All Members shall be deemed to have made themselves familiar with, and agreed to be bound by, the UK Anti-Doping Rules and Skateboard GB's Anti-Doping Policy and to submit to the authority of UK Anti-Doping in the application and enforcement of the Anti-Doping Rules.

3.2. Skateboard GB reserves the right to re-brand or re-name the Types of Affiliate Subscription at any time.

3.3. Types of Affiliate Subscription rights are not transferable to another organisation or individual.

4. Benefits

4.1. All Members and Affiliates are eligible to receive certain benefits provided by Skateboard GB. The price and duration of the relevant benefits are subject to change over time and are at the sole and absolute discretion of Skateboard GB.

5. Application for Membership or Affiliate Subscription, Renewal Payment and Upgrades

5.1. Any person may apply to become a Member within one of the Types of Membership Subscription referred to in paragraph 2 above. Types of Membership Subscription can be applied for by completing any application form via the membership portal on the website www.skateboardgb.org

5.2 Any relevant organisation or individual may apply to become an affiliate within one of the Types of Affiliate Subscription referred to in paragraph 2 above. Types of Affiliate Subscription can be applied for by completing the relevant application form via the membership portal on the website <u>www.skateboardgb.org</u>

5.3. Skateboard GB shall be entitled to refuse an application form, or suspend, or cancel the Membership or Affiliate Subscription of any individual or organisation in its absolute discretion. Skateboard GB is not obliged to provide reasons for any action taken of this nature. However, potential reasons include, but are not limited to, breach of the Regulations or these Terms and Conditions, or an instruction from the Disciplinary and Grievance Panel or Safeguarding Case Management Group.

5.4. Skateboard GB Membership and Affiliate Subscription commences from the day of purchase and expires after 12 months.

5.5. Membership and Affiliate Subscription can be renewed subject to payment of the relevant subscription fee for the subsequent year at any time up to two months in advance of the expiry date. Regardless of the renewal date within this two month period the new Membership or Affiliate Subscription will start the day after the previous Membership or Affiliate Subscription ends.

6.7. If a Membership or Affiliate Subscription is not renewed by the expiry date it will cease with immediate effect.

6.8. Payment must be made online via Skateboard GB's online registration portal on the Skateboard GB website.

6.9. If selected within the registration portal, Membership or Affiliate Subscription will be automatically renewed and the Member or Affiliate will automatically be charged the relevant subscription price on an annual basis until the Member or Affiliate instructs to cancel the Membership or Affiliate Subscription before the end of the year.

7. Changes to Terms and Conditions

7.1. Skateboard GB may amend these Terms and Conditions at any time and Members and Affiliates should therefore check them each time they renew their Membership or Affiliate Subscription. The terms and conditions applying to Membership and Affiliate Subscription will be those in place on the date of purchase.

8. Expiry, Cancellation and Refunds

8.1. Upon expiry of a Membership or Affiliate Subscription all rights and benefits in respect of that Membership or Affiliate Subscription will cease.

8.2. When purchasing a Membership, Members have a seven-day cooling off period during which the subscription can be cancelled and a full refund received unless during that sevenday period the Member has competed in a Skateboard GB competition run by Skateboard GB or an Affiliate organisation.

8.3. If a Member decides to cancel their Membership Subscription after this seven-day period, no refund will be received (unless Skateboard GB in its absolute discretion decides to).

8.4. If an Affiliate decides to cancel their Affiliate Subscription, no refund will be received (unless Skateboard GB in its absolute discretion decides to).

9. Data Protection

9.1. Skateboard GB collects personal information when an individual or organisation becomes a Member or Affiliate, or when a Member or Affiliate uses services or products that require the collection of personal information.

9.2. Skateboard GB will use this information to provide the services requested, maintain records, notify members and affiliates of important information regarding a Membership or Affiliate Subscription (such as renewal notices), develop the organisation and, if the Member or Affiliate agrees, send the Member or Affiliate information on things which may be of interest to them.

9.3. Skateboard GB may occasionally pass such information to its suppliers/partners to receive services or products relating to Membership or Affiliate Subscription that are not fulfilled directly by Skateboard GB. Unless explicitly stated, Skateboard GB does not share such information for marketing purposes with any other organisations.

9.4. Members and Affiliates should review the Skateboard GB Privacy Policy for further information as to how their personal data is handled.

10. Minors

10.1. If a Member is a Minor (child or young adult who is not yet 18), the parent/carer of the Registered Individual must agree to comply with the Skateboard GB Code of Conduct.

10.2. The Skateboard GB Codes, Regulations Rules, and Policies apply to all Members, including Minors (children and young adults who are not yet 18), and in accordance with the Anti-Doping Policy, all Registered Individuals are subject to drug testing. For the purposes of those rules, consent of a parent or carer to the testing of a minor is deemed to follow automatically from the fact that the minor has been permitted by their parent/carer to participate in skateboarding.
